Mick's 8 final heat losses have been against 5 different surfers; 02 Brazil lost to Taj Burrow ... 02 Pipeline & 05 Pipeline lost to Andy Irons ... 03 Brazil, 08 Gold Coast & 08 J-Bay lost to Kelly Slater ... 06 France lost to Joel Parkinson ... 07 Tahiti lost to Damien Hobgood.

The surfers that Mick has met in the final heat of Dream Tour event; Kelly Slater 3, yet to beat him in a final ... Andy Irons 2, yet to beat him in a final ... Damien Hobgood 2 the score is 1 all ... Taj Burrow 2, the score is also 1 all.

The locations where Mick has made the final heat the most time; Bells Beach he has surfed the final series in 6 of the last 8 season for 1 victory ... J-Bay he has surfed the final series 4 of the last 7 seasons for 2 victories ... Brazil he has made the final series in 4 of the last 7 season for 2 victories ... Gold Coast he has made the final series in 4 of the last 6 season for 2 victories ... Trestles he has surfed the final series in 4 of the last 6 season and is yet to win there ... France he has surfed the final series there in 2 of the last 3 season for 2 victories ... Search events he has surfed in final series in 2 of the 4 years since the Search started for a victory in the first Search on Reunion Island.
